INTRODUCTION

Our Founder Joyce Obaseki was a former teacher and 5 years ago a bedraggled boy walked into her classroom crying because he had been bullied again for wearing a dirty uniform to school. She decided to dig deeper and asked why his uniform was always dirty and what he told her next broke her heart. He told her that his mum was currently too ill to wash his clothes. His mum had a chronic illness - cancer and was struggling daily to cope and although she had asked him to wash his clothes he had forgotten to put them in the wash himself. Joyce realised that this child was not at risk but in need. She tried to offer support but was turned down because she was a teacher and not a charity. She tried researching outside agencies that could offer practical support and there was none. After this event, she vowed to make sure that she would do whatever she could to make sure that children like Steven have the practical support they need at home. This was the inspiration behind the launch of **Grant a Smile**.

1 in 4 children in the UK are suffering a similar fate to Steven and have a parent battling a life limiting health condition. **Grant a Smile** is the UK's first and only intervention support service outside the hospitals seeking to fill in the gap in the provision of support for children whose parent(s) are battling chronic, mental health and life-threatening medical conditions. We go into their family homes to clean, de-clutter, iron, do the gardening etc – all for **FREE**. The aim is to improve their quality of life, offer the gift of a clean and healthy home and put a smile on their faces. We don't stop there; we do all we can to grant very special wishes to their unsung heroes - their children.

We strongly believe that together as a community we can create magic in the lives of people who are unable to do what many of us do with ease. We can't do this alone. We need your partnership so we can touch more lives!

In areas where we have no volunteers, we use our paid, vetted and professional cleaners to carry out fortnightly or monthly cleaning sessions. Depending on what is convenient for our service users.

Grant A Smile employs carefully selected, vetted and reliable cleaners. All our volunteers and paid staff have enhanced DBS check and are trained to support our service users. They are compassionate, kind and caring. They will be paid directly by **Grant A Smile** whose funds are generated by public donations. Corporate donors cover our operating costs so that all 100% of public donations go directly towards offering home support to families in need.


A clean home is taken for granted by people who are fit and healthy.

SILENT AUCTION

If you're able to plan and manage a bigger event, you should think about hosting a silent auction.

Donors will enjoy getting the chance to bid on rare items and experiences while you raise a lot of money!

To host your silent auction, you'll need plenty of volunteers to help guests place bids, a venue for your event, and, of course, items to auction off. You can look to peers and local businesses to donate in-kind gifts for your event.

WALKATHONS

Host a walkathon for an active and exciting fundraiser that will involve your entire community.

To plan your walkathon, you have to pick out a date and location. Don't forget to plan out the route so your participants have somewhere to walk!

To raise funds, you'll need to charge an admission fee to participants or ask participants to get sponsorships.

WINE TASTING

Everyone could use a relaxing wine tasting, and your donors would love to participate in this experience.

Partner with a local winery to organize and manage this event.

Charge a small admission fee and accept contributions throughout event. Whether it's a sunny day sampling or a casual evening tasting fine wines in the vineyard, this event is sure to rake in donations.

T-SHIRTS SALES

Looking for an easy way to unite your supporters as a community and raise money? Try selling t-shirts!

This is a great addition to another fundraising event because you can sell your t-shirts and have donors wear them to show their support.

You'll need to partner with a wholesale provider to begin. Look for a one that doesn't require you to buy a lot of merchandise to avoid getting stuck with a bunch of leftover products.

50/50 RAFFLE

A 50/50 raffle is an easy fundraiser to raise money with and it pairs perfectly with larger events.

With a 50/50 raffle, the prize is half of the money raised from the raffle ticket sales. The more tickets people buy, the more they might win!

Remember to let donors buy as many raffle tickets as they please. You might even think about offering bundle ticket specials to encourage more donations!

KARAOKE NIGHT

Everyone loves a night filled with fun and singing!

To host your event, you'll need karaoke equipment, so see if you can rent what you need!

Hosting a karaoke night can bring your workplace and community together to help support a great cause such as **Grant A Smile!** Throughout the event, let people know why you're raising funds and express gratitude for their contributions.
